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Trust & Honesty

One of the main reasons people can trust us, is that we are honest. We can't demand that people trust us if, we are not honest with them.

Interestingly in a relationship, some people like to tell little lies, including age, income, the type of people they are looking for, etc. The lies also include hiding other ongoing relationships, or even marriages, hiding the true motive of their dating, etc.

There are some other little lies, such as: "I will call you", but never do; "I am very busy", which really means "I am not interested"; etc.

Sometimes, small lies can escape causing serious trouble. Some lies do not become a big deal to someone else. Some lies are even understandable. But if you keep doing this, it will become habitual lying. You will need to use another lie to cover the previous lie.

No matter what kind of lie, or how small it is, people will feel difficulty in establishing trust with you. Their logic is "if he can't be honest over such a small thing, how can I trust him over a big thing".

When people start lying, it also encourages the partner to lie as well. Both try to hide things from each other. Both like to make up stories for things they don't want to do. How can they then establish a peaceful and trusting relationship?

To win trust, we must be encouraged to tell the truth, to be honest to ourselves and to be honest to the people we are dealing with. Being honest can hurt, or be hurt, sometimes. But honesty makes our heart lighter. Even if the relationship doesn't work eventually, at least we don't feel guilty. An old word saying it makes us sleep well at night.

On the other hand, honesty also needs to be tied in

with good communication skills and good tolerance to other people.

To be honest doesn't mean we have the right to criticize people, or to force our opinion on to others, or not to be sensitive about other people's emotions. While being honest in expressing ourselves, we need to be sensitive, to know which way is the best way to deliver our message, so the other party can accept it. While being honest, we also need to be aware that people have their own right to think what they think, or to do the things they think are right. Our "honest opinion" may need to be reserved in some occasions.

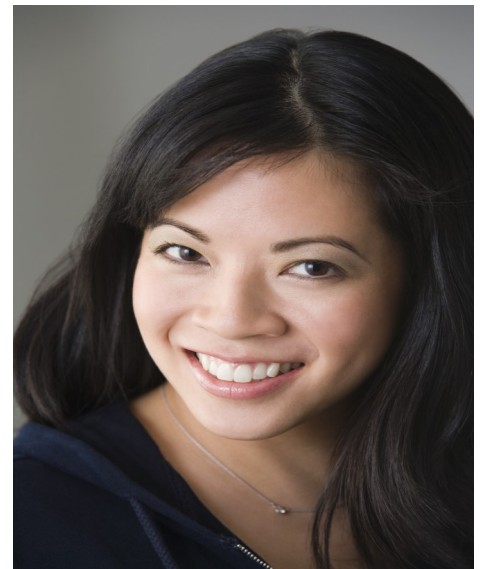
